- 1 Etchart Privado Torrontés, Salta - Argentina £17.90
Softly spiced, fresh, floral delight, dry with unmistakably fragrant characters, unique to Argentina.
- 2 Gavi, Enrico Serafino - Italy £19.90
This refreshingly dry wine shows subtle floral notes on the nose, and has a tangy, minerally palate.
- 3 Chablis, Bouchard Aîné & Fils - France £26.50
Typical light, fresh and fruity nose with mineral aromas, white flowers and hints of fresh peach: the palate is dry with a citrusy freshness.
- 4 Chablis 1er Cru Les Beuroy, Domaine Marguerite Carillon - France £35.00
Typical fresh, minerally palate with the richness of fruit expected from a Premier Cru Chablis.

Dry, herbaceous or aromatic white

- 5 Vavasour Sauvignon Blanc, Awatere Valley - New Zealand £19.90
Flaunts a powerful bouquet of fresh herbs, tomato stalk and blackcurrant, layered with ripe stone fruit and bright citrus flavours.
- 6 Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine Jean-Claude Chatelain - France £24.90
Sauvignon Blanc in full glory with a flinty aroma opening into a determined gooseberry crunchiness. Arguably the finest dry, white from the Loire region.
- 7 Son Excellence Sauvignon Blanc, Côtes de Gascogne - France (HOUSE) £4.70 £6.00 £16.50
Fresh and zesty white, with citrus, blackcurrant leaf and tropical fruit notes.
- 8 Nederburg Ingenuity White, Western Cape - South Africa £39.00
Fresh green aromas layered with floral, peach and spice notes: creamy-textured with a core of racy acidity.

Juicy, fruit-driven, ripe white

- 9 Pontebello Pinot Grigio, South-Eastern Australia - Australia (HOUSE) £4.40 £5.80 £15.90
Fresh with notes of ripe peach and citrus, backed by a touch of richness.
- 10 Berri Estates Unoaked Chardonnay, South-Eastern Australia - Australia (HOUSE) £4.40 £5.80 £15.90
A crisp style with a fresh, yet ripe lemon character with no oak-ageing.
- 11 Viña Somoza Godello Selección, Valdeorras - Spain £29.00
A richly textured, complex, dry white: exhibiting notes of pineapple, white peach and honeysuckle.
- 12 Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch - South Africa £17.90
Ripe and silky-smooth, from South Africa's most popular white grape variety with rich guava fruit and honeyed character.

Full-flavoured, nutty, oaked white

- 13 Viña Pomal Viura-Malvasía Rioja Blanco - Spain £18.50
Rich with an aromatic citrus and white fruit character and a note of spice.
- 14 Meursault, Louis Jadot - France £55.00
A superb reason to explore this region - layers of pineapple and citrus fruit tumble with rich toasted nuttiness.

Refreshing, racy, medium-sweet white

- 15 Dr L Riesling Mosel, Loosen Bros. - Germany £20.50
Classic Mosel raciness: grapefruit and lime with mineral notes and a touch of spritz on the finish.

Rosé

- 16 Vinuva Pinot Grigio Rosé delle Venezie - Italy (HOUSE) £4.40 £5.90 £15.90
A delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas.
- 17 Vendange White Zinfandel, California - USA (HOUSE) £4.40 £5.90 £15.90
A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.
- 18 Château de Fesles Rosé d'Anjou - France £18.50
Off-dry with generous, ripe strawberry and plum fruit and hints of Asian spice.

Light, simple, delicate red

- 19 La Campagne Merlot, Pays d'Oc - France (HOUSE) £4.40 £5.90 £15.90
A rich, juicy southern French wine using this popular variety which originated from Bordeaux.
